Fuel filtration technology slashes council fleet costs

The introduction of new in line diesel filtration technology is saving Lake Macquarie City Council \$22,000 a year, with Newcastle City Council among a raft of other local governments also seeking to implement the system.

Improved Fuel Economy

The introduction of Filter Technology Australia's filtration system helped Lake Macquarie achieve up to 2% improvement in the fuel economy of its fleet of diesel vehicles, representing a saving of around 15,000 litres of fuel per annum.

Reduced Greenhouse Emissions

The fleet's greenhouse emissions were consequently also reduced by 40 tonnes per year.

Breakdowns Reduced Dramatically

The increased quality of fuel delivered to the engine resulted in breakdowns dropping from 70 – 80 per annum to negligible levels.

Less Disposal and Landfill Costs

Longer life and reduction in the usage of OEM filtration products can cut landfill by as much as 80%, reducing costly environmental disposal fees.
